WILNE 10K ROAD RACE – SUNDAY 2nd SEPTEMBER 2018, 10AM
ROAD CLOSURES IN YOUR AREA

Following the seven successful Wilne 10k events between 2011-2017, the event is set to return on Sunday 2nd September 2018. We are pleased to announce that the Wilne 10k 2018 will again be part of the Midlands Road Running League as well as hosting the Midland Masters AC 10k Championships and the Derbyshire Athletics 10k Championships. The event as usual is attracting some of the best athletes from around the country to take part so we encourage you to come and spectate.

The race will start on Sawley Road between the Church Wilne Water Sports Club and Draycott; follow the Church Wilne loop anti-clockwise for one and three-quarter laps and will finish after the Wilne Lane/Sawley Road junction. A course map is available at www.wilne.co.uk

A temporary traffic order has been authorised by Erewash Borough Council and can also be viewed on our website. Gallagher Traffic Management have been contracted to close these roads and will operate a road diversion.

There will be Police No Waiting cones placed on parts of Lodge Street, South Street, Lower Market Street and between The Pines to opposite Attewell Close on Sawley Road the day before the race. Maps showing the positioning of the cones are available on our website. Failure to comply to this order may lead to vehicles being towed without warning. This is for the safety of the runners and to avoid thousands of runners having to pass closely to your vehicles.

During the road race, there will be no movement of vehicles for the safety of competitors, volunteers and spectators. If you have an emergency on the morning of Sunday 2nd September, please speak to a marshal in a yellow bib who will communicate to Event Control.
